EIFFEL Scholarships in a nutshell

The Eiffel Excellence Scholarship Programme is funded by the French Ministry of Foreign Affairs.

It aims at attracting outstanding International students identified by French institutions of higher education.

Grant duration

The Eiffel scholarship is awarded for the duration of the course leading to the qualification mentioned in the application, provided the student fulfils each year's academic requirements.

Grant amount

Eiffel scholars receive a monthly allowance of 1,181€ (2007/08 figure, subject to change in 2008/09). In addition, the programme meets various expenses including return travel, health insurance, extra French language courses and cultural activities. Scholars may also be eligible for additional accommodation allowance.

Application procedure

Applications for Eiffel scholarships are submitted by French Higher Education Institutions.

Applications are not accepted from students themselves, **or from non-French institutions.**

How to apply

Once admitted by the ESSEC MBA Program (Beginning of December 2008), you will be emailed a copy of the Eiffel application file, pre-filled by ESSEC in accordance with your curriculum at ESSEC.

The final results will come out **mid-March 2009** and the scholarship will become effective as of the beginning of the 2009-10 academic year.

Admission requirements for the ESSEC MBA

- Bachelor's level minimum
- Diversity of Majors is welcome : Engineering, Sciences, Humanities, Business, Politics, Languages, etc
- GMAT (700 minimum for a scholarship) or the TAGE-MAGE (400 minimum for a scholarship).
- IELTS or TOEFL. French speaking students may take TOEIC instead.
- No work experience required. In this case, participants will have to complete at least 18 month internships integrated in the Programme.
- Short listed applicants will be interviewed in China by ESSEC alumni
- Upper age limit : 29
- Total tuition fees : 35 000 Euros (for 2008 intake, subject to change for 2009 intake)
