In the fall 2021, EICAR welcomes its students in an all new location. Located in Ivry-sur- Seine, this state of the art campus featuring 6900m2 will offer the latest equipment dedicated to practical audio visual work: a recording studio with sound proof cabin, 30 work stations for sound post production, Image and VFX workstations, a cinema that holds 200 people, 8 shooting stages, one of which will be totally devoted to motion capture technology.











EXCELLENCE LEARNING

Ynov Campus is the French specialist for careers featuring digital technology. Ynov Campus has created interdisciplinary studies, to offer students a wide range of complementary courses, incorporating the latest information technologies and modes of communication. Innovation is at the heart of what we offer. Our programs anticipate changes in technology and offer the student the means to keep ahead of them. The Ynov campuses are located in Aix-en- Provence, Bordeaux, Nantes, Lyon, Paris and Toulouse.



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The Bachelor and the Master of Fine Arts programs are designed to give students professional preparation for a career in film, television or digital media. This is accomplished through theoretical courses and practical exercises as well as extensive hands-on film work where students have the opportunity to master the technical and aesthetic principles of filmmaking. The one year film fundamentals gives students an excellent basis in all the disciplines of filmmaking and does allow students to continue in the BFA if they have the necessary pre requisites.

BACHELOR OF FINE ART

- The first year consists of mastering the fundamentals in the key disciplines of film-making in a predominately hands-on film curriculum coupled with theoretical and film culture classes in the first and second terms. The emphasis is on documentary. The third term, students will only work, in various capacities, on student productions.
- In the second year, students will choose an option directing, production, cinematography, screenwriting or editing with an emphasis on fiction and directing actors.. During the second term, students have additional required courses in their option as well as workshops, and one-to-one tu- toring.
- In the third and final year, the emphasis is on the student's final film project in the area of their option. All third year courses and workshops are tailored to the specificities of the students' final project film.

MASTER OF FINE ART

The MFA 2 year Program at EICAR is the only English language Masters program in film in continental Europe

- The first year consists of courses in the key disciplines of filmmaking as well as hands-on film exercises and shorts. Mature students start with fundamentals but quickly progress to advanced areas in all the five disciplines. The emphasis is on fiction.
- In the second year, the focus is on student's final project film in the area of their option directing, production, cinematography, screenwriting or editing. Students have additional required courses in their option as well as workshops, and one-to-one tutoring.

ONE YEAR FILMMAKING PROGRAM

The One Year Filmmaking Program is a one year comprehensive program in filmmaking introducing students to the fundamentals and to documentary. The student has the option of taking all the core classes available to a first year Bachelor student and augmenting the experience with a few chosen workshops. The final term is a production term that allows one year students to cement their learning by performing key positions.

SUMMER WORKSHOP

MAKING A SHORT: The intensive two week filmmaking workshop is designed to give students a thorough introduction to the craft of filmmaking through hands-on experience.
