Insight: AP/IB knowledge (especially in Economics) is just a prerequisite.

I believe the courses designed (courses are fixed in the Bachelor Cycle) for students (30 ECTS/Semester) are more well-rounded and more challenging than most of the other bachelor programs globally. Mathematics, Economics, Law, Business English, and Business-related courses such as Marketing are heavily weighted, however, unique classes such as Creativity, Artistic Culture & Expression, Drama, and Sports Management allow us to continually step out of our comfort zones to discover our artistic and intellectual potential, especially for students educated in Asia.

The studying atmosphere is very competitive because we all want to exchange to the best schools possible - the higher you ranked (global average/ or GPA), the better options you will have. 
Facilities (4/5)







